

WOODLEA OUTDOOR CINEMA FAQ'S

SATURDAY 17TH FEBRUARY

How do I get there?

The Woodlea Outdoor Cinema is located at the Woodlea Stage 1 Park, adjacent to Go West at 27 Woodlea Boulevard, Aintree (Rockbank) 3335.

Where can I park?

There is limited off street parking around the venue. Please ensure you allow enough time to find a park in the neighbouring streets and be prepared to walk.

What time do the gates open and the films start?

Gates open at 6.00pm. Screenings start at sundown (approximately 8.30pm).

What food and drinks are available?

There will be a small selection of food available, as well as delicious treats and drinks from our candy bar. Please note no alcohol will be available for purchase.

Can I BYO?

You are most welcome to BYO food and drinks (including alcohol), or enjoy something from our onsite food options. Glass will not be permitted due to OH&S.

Excessive consumption of alcohol is prohibited at all times during the event, and Woodlea reserves the right to ask any patron to leave the venue if behaving inappropriately.

Can I smoke?

Woodlea Outdoor Cinema is a smoke-free event.

What are the seating arrangements?

A limited number of bean beds are available for hire at the venue for \$10. Turn up early as we may sell out! Alternatively, you can bring your own bean bags, cushions, blankets and rugs. If you need to bring a chair, you will be directed to sit behind all other patrons at the cinema.

What should I wear / bring?

The Woodlea Outdoor Cinema is an outdoor cinema, and the park can get cold once the sun goes down! Be prepared and pack a jumper just in case. Layer up and/or bring a blanket to snuggle under, and you'll have a cosy night. Bean beds can be hired at the venue but are limited, so we recommend you bring a picnic rug and pillows just in case. If it's been a bit wet, we encourage you to bring something to keep dry, just in case. Ponchos and plastic picnic rugs are always a good option. Pack some insect repellent. We all know what Summer in Australia is like, particularly around parklands!

What if it rains?

As an outdoor event the Woodlea outdoor Cinema is subject to weather. We aim to go ahead with all screenings, and do not cancel for light/intermittent/potential rain. We strongly recommend you bring wet weather gear to screenings in case of rain.

Screenings will be cancelled only if the weather poses a safety threat to guests and staff.
