

Important COVID-19 Information

Exclusion of Liability Provision

Whilst JCU and all other persons who participate in the organisation and conduct of the UniX 2023 and its activities have taken and will take all reasonable care to avoid injury to persons or damage to or loss of property whilst attending the event, JCU and those other persons shall not be liable for personal injury or property loss or damage of any kind whatsoever, other than injury loss or damage directly attributable to failure to take reasonable care on the part of JCU or those other persons.

In the event of any injury to my child, I give permission for any necessary medical treatment to be carried out by a legally qualified medical practitioner. Should this be necessary, I understand that I will be notified as soon as possible and that I am responsible for covering all medical costs.

I confirm that I have read the exclusion of liability provision (see above) and by signing the Parent/Guardian Authority

I accept these terms of exclusion on my own behalf and on behalf of my child.

I agree that if my child demonstrates any behaviour that is disruptive or negative to the group's enjoyment of the experience, I will accept my child may be excluded to participate in the remainder of the event and returned to his/her room.

I agree that my child will be required to observe all directions given by JCU supervisors with respect to safety, the use of JCU equipment and facilities and interaction with other persons (including other students) during the experience.

I agree to compensate JCU and any other owner of property for any damage which my child willfully or negligently causes to their property during this event.

Student Attendance and Code of Conduct

We want everyone to enjoy their visit to JCU for UniX. Please read the Code of Conduct and confirm that you will abide by it, by signing the Parent/Guardian Authority.

Code of Conduct

To ensure that everyone taking part has a rewarding and enjoyable time and for your child's protection we ask that they to agree to and abide by the following:

1. Not permitted to leave the campus on their own or in a student group;
2. Follow any emergency procedures, as directed by JCU staff;
3. JCU is first and foremost an educational facility, while on campus students must respect those around them by refraining from making excessive noise;
4. Be involved in dangerous activities that could cause injury to them, other people and/or cause damage to property;
5. The purchase/supply/possession and/or use of any illegal substances is strictly forbidden;
6. The program works through mutual respect and co-operation. All participants must therefore respect individuals of different races, cultures, religions, genders, sexual orientations and disabilities. Abusive and anti- social behaviour and language will not be tolerated.
7. There will be separate male/female sleeping and bathroom accommodation. You will be expected to keep to your own areas at specific times, which you will be told about on your first day.
8. Accommodation must be left tidy at all times and computer and other resources used responsibly and in accordance with the policy on acceptable computer use at JCU.

Serious incidents of misbehaviour:

In the unfortunate event of serious incidents of misconduct, such as fighting, abusive or antisocial behaviour, or the use of illegal substances, student(s) concerned will not be allowed to continue with the program and arrangements will be made for the student(s) to be removed immediately.

I am aware that UniX activities will be supervised at all times by employees of JCU and Education Queensland, with program activities undertaken by staff and students employed by JCU.

Accommodation

Townsville – selected accommodation facilities include John Flynn College and Saints Catholic College. Located at the JCU Townsville campus, accommodation range from single dormitory style rooms with shared bathroom facilities to apartment style (twin or three) bedrooms with shared bathroom facilities. School teachers will be accommodated on site, and all the facilities have an onsite manager.

Cost

The accommodation cost for each participant is \$110 per night, including meals. Accommodation costs will be coordinated between JCU and your school, who may pass on the full or part there of costs associated with accommodation.
