# Telstra Wholesale National Stop Sell of Carrier Grade Ethernet, Wholesale Transmission, Ethernet Backhaul, BDAS, Business Grade Ethernet and ATM

We're writing to let you know that Telstra Wholesale will be ceasing to supply any new services supplied over fibre nationally for 6 legacy data products on and from 01 January 2020. Upgrade and downgrade orders on existing services supplied under these legacy data products will continue to be taken until further notice.

The products that are affected by this stop sell are set out in the table below.

The stop sell will be applied to new services supplied over fibre for both existing customers and customers who have not previously acquired the legacy data products.

Telstra has previously announced that WTX, BDAS Lite, BDAS Standard, Wholesale ATM and ATM (Rebill) services that are supplied over copper and are being migrated to the nbn are subject to a NBN service withdrawal process. This notice does not affect any existing NBN service withdrawal process.
